School Mission Statement:

Purpose:

Knowledgeum Academy aims to provide the final four years of schooling in the 5+3+3+4 format, as proposed by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Curriculum Pathway:

1. Cambridge IGCSE (Class 9 & 10)
Cambridge AS and A Level (Class 11 & 12)
OR
2. Cambridge IGCSE (Class 9 & 10)
International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (Class 11 & 12)

Why Cambridge and IBDP

- To provide an opportunity for learners to choose subjects of their choice and decide on a field for higher studies and career path
- To provide value-added education with essential skills where the learners become confident and clear in thought and action
- To provide globally recognised qualifications
- To instil qualities such as critical thinking, logical reasoning, decision making, and effective communication through academic rigour and quality assessment
- To provide a progressive curriculum and an opportunity for research and learner reflection

Description:

Cambridge IGCSE

Candidates can join the academy in class 9 through the Cambridge IGCSE programme. The Cambridge IGCSE programme is for over the period of two academic years. Students will take up the February/March assessment series of the Cambridge examinations in the second academic year (class 10).

Cambridge AS/A Level or IBDP

After the successful completion of Cambridge IGCSE, students may opt for any academic program at the pre-university level (Class 11 and 12). Cambridge AS/A level students will take the final assessment in the February/March series of Cambridge examinations and IBDP students will take up the assessment in the month of May.

Direct Entry:

As prescribed in the admission policy of the academy, students can register for Cambridge AS/A level or IBDP after the completion of their class 10 examinations or equivalent.
